Contraindications List

If you have any of the below conditions during the time of your treatment you will unfortunately not be able to have your lashes applied. If you suffer from any of the below symptoms before you're a[ppointment but after you have booked please make sure you inform you technician so you can reschedule your appointment.

- Conjunctivitis, styles, cysts, blepharitis (inflamed painful eyelids).
- Cuts or abrasions to the eye area.
- Swollen or sensitive skin around the eyes.
- Eczema or psoriasis around the eyes.
- Recent eye surgery.
- Permanent make up until completely healed (min 8 weeks)
- Botox/Fillers in Forehead and Eye Area (leave min 2 weeks post treatment)
- Weak, brittle eyelashes or conditions, medication that may cause madarosis (loss of eyelashes).
- Glaucoma, Post chemotherapy treatments, Dry eye syndrome - GP referral.
- Check client does not suffer from claustrophobia.
- Check for extremely watery eyes. Treatment could be contraindicated in severe cases.
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Pregnancy is not a contraindication unless you are within your first trimester. Please note that we offer 1-hour volume lashes which may be more comfortable for you as the application time is halved.
